**Moving Image** art fair returns to the Waterfront Tunnel for our sixth edition in New York, with works by 27 international artists represented by 25 international galleries

**Marcos Bonisson and Khalil Charif** in the form of an assembly of Super 8 footage filmed in many different places in Brazil during the 70's (presented by Artur Fidalgo galeria, Rio de Janeiro); a commission by the French-Jamaican artist **Olivia McGilchrist** that explores translocation and issues of Caribbean cultural identity (presented by Davidoff Art Initiative, Basel, Switzerland); a mesmerizing work by New York artist **Anne Spalter** featuring Macchu Piccu (presented by Impakto Galeria, Lima, Peru); and a real-time animated work by the British collective **boredomresearch** (presented by DAM Gallery, Berlin).

Among the large-scale installations at this year's Moving Image New York are a video installation by New York artist **Jennifer Dalton** that chronicles Dalton's attempt over the course of one year to learn to execute a standing backflip (presented by Winkleman Gallery, New York); a video installation in a felt tent by **Amalie Atkins**, which originally debuted at the groundbreaking survey of contemporary Canadian art, *Oh, Canada*, at MASS MoCA in 2012 (presented by dc3 Art Projects, Edmonton, Canada); a large three-channel installation by Greek artist **Kalliopi Lemos** who was the recipient of the Borusan Contemporary Art Collection Prize at Moving Image in Istanbul (presented by Gazelli Art House, London and Baku); and a special presentation of Argentine artist **Sergio Vega's** acclaimed installation *Genesis According to Parrots,* which has been presented at the Venice Biennale, the Palais de Tokyo, and had its US premiere at the Miami art space Jenielift just last month
